

PACIFIC BEACH MIDDLE SCHOOL STANDARD DRESS CODE

The Pacific Beach Middle School Community has encouraged the establishment of a student uniform to focus on student learning and maintaining a safe campus climate. *District Standard dress code* is as follows. *All students will dress in clothing that:*

- does not detract from the learning environment for staff and students
- does not include spikes, chains or studs (including spike earrings, belts, etc.)
- does not represent PE clothing such as mesh shorts, PBMS PE gear or similar garments
- is clean and in good repair with no holes, un-hemmed, frayed or split-seam pants, shorts or cuffs
- is free of any reference to alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, gambling, sex or violence
- is free of any depictions/illustrations that demean or negatively represent any gender, race, color, ethnicity, religion, national origin, disability or sexual orientation
- fits neatly at the waist; **Please note: pants may not “sag” or fit excessively tight.**
- appropriately covers the body. That is, no bare midriffs, tank tops, muscle shirts, spaghetti straps, short shorts or high side-seam cut shorts or skirts. **Please note: shorts, skirts and dresses should reach the tips of the fingers when the arm is extended down the thigh.**
- is not perceived as having a gang affiliation, including bandanas, dangling belts, wallet chains, insignia belts/buckles, sports team jerseys/jackets.
- No headgear, hats or headbands are allowed aside from those with religious significance.
- All shoes must be supportive and have a secure closed toe and heel. Slippers are not allowed.
- Students must still follow district dress code regulations on ASB Spirit Days or “free dress” days

PACIFIC BEACH MIDDLE SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Pacific Beach Middle School’s uniform policy offers students a reasonable choice of practical, attractive attire and eliminates the distractions and expense imposed by costly fashion trends.

All students at Pacific Beach will honor the dress code:

- **NO BLUE JEANS.**
- Must wear logo free solid navy blue, solid khaki or solid white shirts, pants, shorts, skirts, or dresses in any combination.
- PBMS logo shirts and PBMS logo Class/Department shirts
- Outer wear such as jackets or sweaters must also be solid navy blue, solid khaki, or solid white and be **logo-free.**

Dress Code Infractions

Level I: Student conference; dress code reminder/warning.

Level II: Student may be considered defiant, assigned a detention, and required to change.

Level III: Referral to administration, home contact, standard discipline, required to change

Level IV (Habitual): Referral to administration, home contact, severe discipline, required to change
